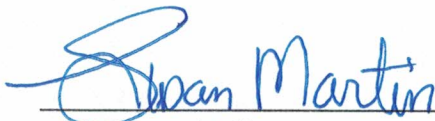

UNFINISHED BUSINESS.

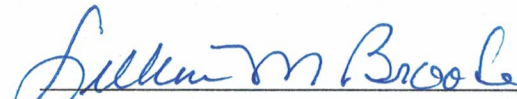
