

VILLAGE OF ANDOVER OPEN BURNING

Section 91.57 of the Ohio Basic Code provides regulations on open burning within the Village of Andover.

The Village is considered a Restricted Area as defined by the Ohio Revised Code and this area extends 1000 feet beyond the Village boundaries and open burning is prohibited in this restricted area.

Open Burning that is allowed in the Village is a “ Camp Fire “ consisting of clean seasoned firewood, natural gas or equivalent or any clean burning fuel with emissions of that are equivalent to or lower than those of using clean seasoned firewood for the purpose of cooking food, recreation, comfort and warmth or pleasure.

Open Burning CAN NOT be used for waste disposal purposes including household trash or yard waste.

The size limit of the campfire is limited to a size of no more than 3 feet around and 2 feet high unless prior approval and proper permits by the Fire Chief.
